WEEK 1 WELCOME

Welcome back to the 2021 school year!

Students have settled into their new classes well and it has been a very calm start to the year. As a result of slightly reduced student numbers we only have 18 classes this year. A small rise in the number of enrolments could however see the number of classes increase. We think that this is unlikely but could be a possibility.

2021 promises to be a big year with the full scope of school activities being planned for. These include camps, sporting events and carnivals, Easter Hat Parades and of course the whole school performance.

I am sure it will be busy but a lot of fun also!

PARENT TEACHER MEETINGS

Parents of students in grades 1-6 will have been sent links for parent teacher interview times.

These interviews will occur via Zoom.

This is an opportunity for you to let the teachers know any relevant information about your children.

Teachers will not be reporting on academic progress during these interviews.

ATTENDANCE

Our school has been set an attendance target of having greater than **88% of students attend school for greater than 90% of the time.** Please help us to achieve this target by sending your students to school every day that they can attend. All non-attendance will be followed up by school staff and unfortunately students whose attendance is not satisfactory must be referred to the Home School Liaison Officer. Students can very quickly slip below 90% attendance as follows.

1 day absent per week = 80% attendance

1 day absent per fortnight = 90% attendance

2 week holiday during school term = 90% attendance

Every day counts for a child's learning. If a child takes a two week holiday every year of their schooling they will have missed three terms of learning!

Current percentage of students who have greater than 90% attendance = 91.5%



BAND

Being part of a musical ensemble or learning an instrument is a fantastic way to expand your child's literacy, numeracy and aural skills. Your child will grow in confidence and self-esteem, increase their team working and co-operation skills and learn to read and play the language of music and of course, have fun!

NLS has a Senior concert Band for students with experience (rehearsals: Monday/Tuesday – 8:00am) and a Junior Band (Wednesday – 8:00am) for students starting with no experience.

Music tuition is offered at school during lunch, recess and after school in OOSH hours.

Your nomination email should include the following information: your child's name, age, chosen sport(s) and level of competition they compete in with regard to their sport(s).


This will be forwarded to Mr Hawke who will receive information from Newcastle City PSSA throughout the term. Please note that this is not a school-based team. Newcastle City emphasises that attendees to the trials are only for the most skilled students who compete regularly in representative level competition. The cost to trial varies between sports and ranges from \$10.00 to \$20.00 and is payable in cash to the Hunter convener on arrival at the trial. The levy covers the cost of the venue hire.

SCHOOL FEES

HATS IN THE PLAYGROUND



A review late last year of the NLSPS Memorandum of Understanding between the P and C and the school, found that the community felt that stronger enforcement of the wearing of hats was required at school. To that end it is a rule that all students must wear hat for outdoor play and lessons.
