YEAR 6 CLAP OUT

Year 6 students will be presented with their graduation books and 2022 captains will deliver their final speech. Students will then leave the hall via a Year 5 guard of honour.

The Clap out will commence at 2.30pm and parents of Year 6 students are welcome to attend.

SIGNING SCHOOL SHIRTS

It is a tradition that year 6 students who are finishing school have a school shirt signed by friends. We ask that students do not have the shirt that they are wearing signed. Year 6 students should wear out of uniform for party day, full school uniform for clap out and bring a spare school shirt and sharpie type marker for signing of the shirts on the last day only.

KINDERGARTEN 2023

Student's heading into kindergarten 2023 will commence school on Tuesday 31 January.

New kindergarten students will spend the week as a large group working with the teachers prior to classes being established. This allows the teachers time to observe and get to know our new students before making decisions regarding class placements.

PARTY DAY

Next Friday 16th December is the final day of school for 2022. To celebrate the end of a busy and amazing year, students will be participating in whole school party day.

Stage 3 students will be travelling to Genesis and then a picnic lunch in the park before returning to school for their clap out assembly.

Students in Kinder to year 4 will remain at school and rotate between activites such as the silent disco, motivate sports Olympic challenge and classroom projects including gift of gratitude.

GIFT OF GRATITUDE





Our school will be participating in an optional 'gift of gratitude' this year, where each child has been given the name of another student in their class and will purchase a small gift for that child. Teachers have already finalised their list and are aware of students who do not wish to participate.

STAGE 3 GAME CHANGER CHALLENGE

This term stage 3 students participated in a design thinking process as part of an integrated English and PDHPE unit. The problem provided to students was:

We have a global challenge of ensuring

healthy lives for all, at all ages. This was derived from United Nations' Sustainable Development Goal 3: Good health and wellbeing.



5/6R had 2 teams progress to the finals of the 2022 Game Changer Challenge.

The first team was Ivy L, Mackenzie M, Wil A and Livie A presenting 'Parkinson's plus': with an idea to help parents and carers to support people with Parkinson's disease.

The second team was Sadie K, Alice W, Ava G, Alex R, Isaac C presenting 'Tents for homelessness:' with an idea to support people without homes in the Newcastle area and provide them with a space that rehabilitates, homes and educates those people.







Both teams used the judge's feedback from their class presentations and significantly improved their ideas to become more innovative.

Parkinson's plus came away as winners on the day, as the judges were impressed with the level of empathy, they were able to implement within the idea and how well the team utilised feedback from the previous week to improve their presentation.

Second place went to 5/6C's Crash Crew who created an app that could stop young drivers from using their mobile phone which can decreased the amount of road fatalities in vulnerable age groups.





Third place to 5/6L's NLS All Stars with an idea to help parents navigate the multitude of

information on the internet relating to childhood illness.

Over the coming weeks teachers will be working together to place students into classes for 2023. There are many complexities involved in placing students including social, emotional academic and behavioral.


Class placements are always designed to maximise the potential of all students. Parental requests for students to be placed with friends or with specific teachers are not considered in this process.
