

GAME CHANGER CHALLENGE

The Game Changer Challenge Grand Final was a fabulous experience! We stayed at the Novotel in Parramatta, a ten minute walk from the Department of Education HQ in Parramatta. We talked to industry partners such as Apple, Amazon and HP. They all helped our team very much and developed our idea, but it was Apple that helped us the most.

The Adreni-Band and Epi-Patch were our ideas. The Adreni-Band detects blood pressure and heart rate. When the Band detects a spike in heart rate and a sudden drop in blood pressure, your watch will vibrate and start beeping. It will show a screen with three buttons, one named false alarm which disengages the anaphylactic attack protocol. If you press the second button labelled unsure, it will ask you how you are feeling every minute for fifteen minutes then it will check in every 15 minutes for 2 hours. The final button is named anaphylactic attack, and if this is pressed, it will inject the patient with Adrenaline and call an ambulance to the location. It injects adrenaline through the Epi-Patch. The Epi-Patch receives a signal from the Adreni-Band via Bluetooth. If none of the buttons are pressed within 20 seconds, the patch will automatically inject and call the ambulance. YEAR 5 SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL 2025 APPLICATIONS CLOSE 20TH NOVEMBER


